The **Terranea Resort** in Rancho Palos Verdes recently added a series of spa bungalows to its expansive property. For adults only, these bungalows are situated next to the resort's spa, gym, and spa pool. They come equipped with foam rollers and resistance bands alongside private fire pits and amenities like pour-over iced tea every afternoon. Stays include spa treatments and a personal fitness consultation, plus every kind of class from seaside TRX to Tai Chi. Outdoor lovers can also opt for hiking and "kayorkeling" (snorkeling with your face while your body stays dry on a kayak).
