The girl **commands** her dog to sit.





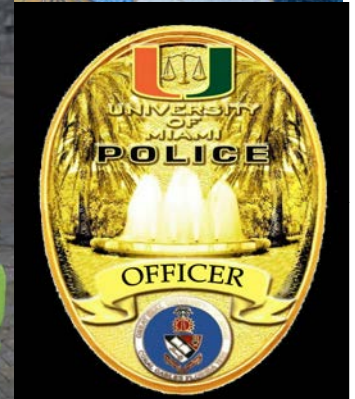
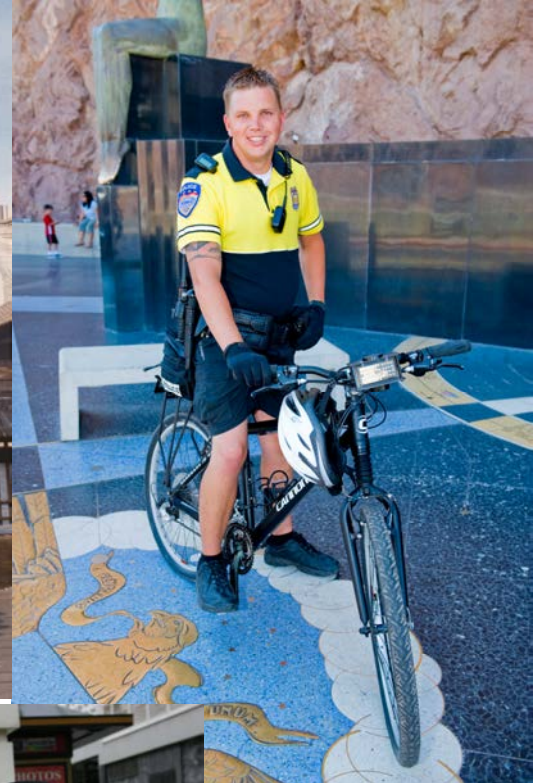

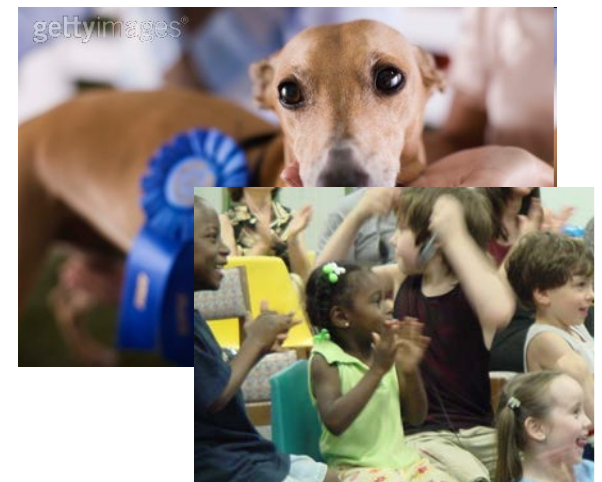
