This workshop will reveal a model of behavior and learning that is simple and at the same time far reaching. With this behavior model, you will learn to unravel many complex issues in a short period of time.

There will be a combination of lecture, video, and hands on work.

Topics include:

- The roots and causes of aggression, and how to relieve them.
- The truth about the social nature of dogs, and how it affects us.
- The secrets of de-stressing an anxious dog.
- Gaining and maintaining trust.
- Non-threatening results based handling.
- Listen with the leash, and using the right tool for the right job.
- Utilizing constant communication.
- How dogs teach, and how dogs learn.
- Creating compliance by avoiding resistance.
- Creating a cooperative mind (get the mind and the body follows).
- The most destructive and common myths about dog behavior.

Who should attend Dogmanship workshops?

Dog Trainers will learn new ways to use familiar equipment, and new ways to explain what they are doing to clients and prospective clients. They will learn practical ways to instruct their clients to increase their success without increasing their homework.

Groomers will learn the secrets of low stress handling allowing happier dogs and faster grooms.

Kennel operators will learn how to safely handle all types of difficult dogs while lowering their stress level, gaining employee morale, healthier dogs, and happier clients.

Dog Walkers will learn how to effectively and easily reduce leash pulling and reactivity to distractions.

Daycare operators will learn how to read body language and understand when (and how) to intervene before there's a problem.

Dog owners will be given a new level of understanding of their dog's behavior that goes far beyond what is readily available from any other source.

Can I bring a dog? Students are encouraged to bring a dog. (Working spaces are limited, so please sign-up early.)

What kind of dog can I bring? Any kind of dog will be useful. Some dogs are not suitable for socialization sessions, but they are valuable for the workshop nonetheless because their evaluations are the most important. However, all dogs should be crate trained, attendees will need to provide their own crate.

How long are the sessions? The workshop will start at 9:00 AM each day with lunch around 12:30. We will resume around 2:00 and go until 4:00 or 4:30 depending on how many questions people are asking.

Who is teaching the workshop? Chad Mackin will be teaching the workshop. Chad has been training dogs professionally since March of 1993. He developed Pack to Basics after being introduced to Large Field Socialization by Dick Russell. Chad immediately recognized the value in what was happening and set about finding a way to make it work in smaller spaces. Chad brought all his years of experience with difficult and aggressive dogs to the problem and over time has developed the program presented in workshops today.

Chad is a former President of The International Association of Canine Professionals, as well as the current Director of Training for DePaw Universtiy Canine Campus inc. He has presented on Pack To Basics at the IACP Conference in Hutto TX, and at National K-9 school for dog trainers, as well as private facilities across the US and in Canada.
