Objectives and questions

Objectives:

 To analyse local livelihood changes according to the change of wetland resources, and gender on the resources utilization

Questions

- How have the wetland resources changed?
- How have the changes impacted on local livelihoods?
- What are the roles of men and women in resource utilization related to the changes?

Types of data and information

• Wetland resources:

- Land area, fish, vegetable, non-timber forest products (NTFPs), water...
- Local livelihoods:
- Income sources, poverty rate, cattle, poultry, land ownership, etc.
- Gender issues:
- Men and women roles in leadership, participation, decision making, etc.



Collection tools

- Focus group discussion: men and women groups
- Open questions
- Semi-structured interview
- Observation
- Site visiting
- Photography
