Important Reminders

Take a break!

We encourage all Journey Groups to break from their routine in the months of June, July, and August. Keep the community element alive with some get-togethers, but break from the regular meetings. This will help your leadership stay fresh, create a sustainable pace of leadership, and provide natural on-ramps and off-ramps for people in the group.

Save the first Sunday

Leadership is dynamic, not static. A good leader is always developing and growing. We want to be part of that development by hosting strategic *Leadership Development* nights. Make these part of your leadership by planning them into your Journey Group schedule. We recommend a 1 off, 3 on schedule - take the first week of the month off and meet the other weeks of the month. If your group meets twice a month, plan to meet on the 2nd/4th weeks. Why mention this now? - summer is the ideal time to make adjustments like these to the group's schedule. Bottom line: everyone's leadership needs to grow; we can help; let's make time for it.

Remember to share

Sharing the leadership in your group is one of the best ways to keep people engaged, develop new leaders, and lighten your load all at the same time. If you don't already have a right-hand-man/woman, take some time during the summer break to tap a group member on the shoulder and invite them to share in the leadership of the group.
