- 4. 2 Corinthians 5:15 reminds us that Jesus' work in us is so radical that it is as if we become new creations. Have you seen this happen in someone's life? What changed in them? In what way(s) do you need to experience Jesus' transforming power in your life right now?
- 5. Lee Stroebel talked of "windows of opportunity" in our lives. Are you standing before one of these windows in your spiritual journey right now? Are you willing to take this opportunity? Do you know someone else who is standing before a window of opportunity? Pray for them together and seek an opportunity to talk with them about it this week.
