1. Where would you most likely be - picketing outside the porn convention or inside at Jake Larson's "Jesus Loves Porn Stars" booth? Which place more closely matches what you know of Jesus?
2. Do you have a story like Crissy Moran's where God met you at a time of brokenness? How did you find/experience God's grace and love at that time? How was God evident in Crissy's life even in the midst of her porn career?
3. Jake Larson equated chasing porn to Adam and Eve eating from the one tree that was forbidden. In what way(s) are they both rejecting God's best for us? In what way(s) do they both bring destruction into our lives?
4. Crissy said, "Knowing that I was wanted and desired is what fueled me [to do porn]." When we give ourselves over to any sin, how are we believing the lie that _____ is better than God? How do we orient our lives so that our deepest desires are met in Jesus so that we don't turn to lesser gods like porn?
5. James 1:13-15 tells us that sin will always lead to death in our lives. Jake gave us three steps to battle this sin of porn so that we can escape death and have life
 1. Confess our sin to God (1 John 1:9) - Why is this more than a cliché? Do you usually feel more forgiven or condemned from God? Why is it hard for us to truly believe Romans 8:1?
 2. Confess to someone else (James 5:16) - Why does this have power? Why do we fear it so much?
 3. Clean out the source - Why is this a necessity? What are some examples of people making radical life changes in the gospels? What would this practically look like if you're battling porn?
6. What needs to change in your heart/life related to pornography?
 - Does your heart match the heart of Jesus for the people involved in the production and consumption of porn?
 - Are you currently involved in porn in your life? Have you taken all 3 steps that Jake recommends? Would you be willing to open up to someone in the group about the problem?
