2 Corinthians 8:1-7

- 1. What is one of your favorite "finish line" moments from sports or some other event? What made it so great to you?
- 2. What part of the DYI vision has most excited you? How have you been part of the DYI vision these past three years?
- 3. If you are part of the 46% who have come to CCC since 10/10/10, how has God impacted your life through your participation at CCC? If you're part of the 54% who have been at CCC before 10/10/10, how have you seen God at work in and through CCC recently?
- 4. In 2 Corinthians 8:1-7, Paul is talking to the Corinthian church about their giving to help the church in Jerusalem. How does it make you feel when the pastor starts talking about giving? This passage talks a lot about grace. How does God's grace motivate us to be people of generosity? What has helped you develop a habit of generosity in your life and your family's life?
- 5. What would be the external evidence of someone who has fully embraced the philosophy that everything they own belongs to God? Reality check: based on my external life, would anyone say I live like everything I have belongs to God? What can we each do tomorrow to help us begin to embrace this philosophy more?
- 6. As Pastor Mark has said, DYI is much more about people than it is money; the money is just a tool to reach people. As your group ends, take some time to pray individually and in pairs:
 - Individually pray, "God, do whatever it takes in me to accomplish Your will through me." As you pray this, take time to sit in silence to allow the Holy Spirit to speak to you.
 - In pairs pray for the person whose name you wrote or will write on the wall. What might be the next step in leading them toward Jesus?
