4 Sessions

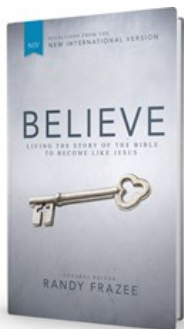

30 Days to Live

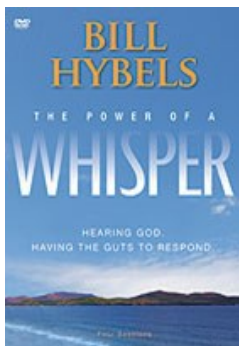
4 Sessions

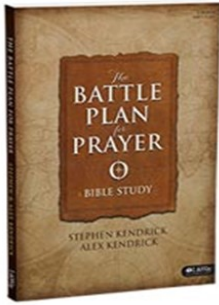
Believe, NIV

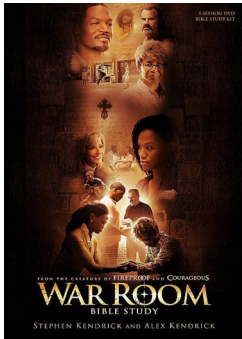
War Room Movie Group Curriculum
