



Everybody Wins: When Barriers Get Smashed

1. What was the combined service, with Morning Star Baptist, like for you?
2. Dr. LeRoy Adams asked, “What kind of world would we have if everyone loved Jesus?” What do you imagine that would be like?
3. Read John 4:1-26 – Racism was real between the Jews and the Samaritans. So much so they would avoid each other at all costs. How do you see this playing out today? (Workplace? Neighborhood? Country? World?)
4. Think about the qualities Jesus exhibits throughout this passage. How do they help accomplish his mission to love all people well?
5. Think about prejudices that are common today. Can you identify any specific ones in your heart? (i.e. race, gender, status, culture, religion, etc) What is one step you can take to begin smashing through this barrier?
6. What’s one thing you can do to cross barriers today and love like Jesus?
7. What’s at stake, for the world, if the Church does not confront their barriers and love like Jesus did?

Throughout this series, we have been praying for people so everybody can win. As we have been praying for people that don’t know Jesus, how are you making connections with them? What can you do to be intentional in your interactions? Take the last five minutes of group and break into smaller groups to pray.
