### NOTES ON EXAMINATIONS/ EXAMINATION ROOM RULES

#### All examinations (except Mathematics courses) have a 10 minute reading time. Reading starts 8:30am and 12:45pm

Students should ensure they are at the examination venue **20 minutes** before the start of reading time as you will be directed into the examination room at least 10-15 minutes before it commences. No extra time is given for lateness. No allowance will be made to students who miss an examination through misreading the timetable.

- 1. Students must enter the examination room quietly. Once in the room they may not communicate with any other students. Students are to remain silent until they leave the examination room after the exam is over and has been collected (no communication of any kind should occur with other students in the room).
- 2. Mobile phones, iPads, smart watches, bags etc are not permitted into the Examination room they are to be left in student lockers. Students found to be in possession of one of these devices in the examination room will be deemed to have broken examination rules.
- 3. Students are not permitted to bring unauthorised materials into the examination room. All unauthorised material must be left at the front of the room.
- 4. No student is to borrow any equipment. You must NOT bring a pencil case into the examinations. Your pens, pencils etc must be in a clear plastic pocket.
- 5. If students have a question or need assistance they must raise their hand and wait for the examination supervisor to come to their desk before asking the question.
- 6. Students may not pick up or use a pen or any other equipment during reading time.
- 7. The Corpus Christi College Examination Policy applies in full at all times.
- 8. Students are not required to attend the College during the examination period when they do not have a timetabled examination unless directed by Mr Papineau or Mr Messer.
- 9. Students studying courses which do not have an examination component, will only be required to attend the College during this period if they need to complete outstanding tasks or assessment work.
- 10. **Full winter or summer uniform** is required at all times when on the school property and attending examinations during the Examination Weeks. No mixing or matching of uniforms.
- 11. Please check carefully the **STARTING TIME** and **FINISHING TIME** of your respective examinations. If your exam finishes outside of normal school hours then you must arrange your own transport home, you may NOT leave an examination early.
- 12. Students are not permitted to leave early from an examination.
