## Lansing Park Millage

#### What is the Lansing Park Millage?

Every five years, the citizens of the City of Lansing are asked to approve one (1) mill of property taxes to operate and maintain the City's parks and recreation system. The Lansing Park Millage is used for park and playground improvements, as well as matching funds for state and federal grant programs. Over the past five years, more than \$4 million in state and federal funds were leveraged to improve our park system.

## Will this result in an increase of my current property taxes?

**NO!** This is a renewal of an existing millage. Your property taxes will not increase as a result of the millage renewal.

#### What is my current cost?

Remember – this is a renewal of an existing millage. Your property taxes <u>will not</u> increase.


