God is holy (set apart)

1 Peter 1:15-16 But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; for it is written: "**Be holy, because I am holy.**"

Holy =
set apart
sacred
consecrated
clean, pure

As opposed to:
common
defiled
desecrated
unclean, impure

"Be holy"—God made you holy (He set you apart to Himself)

1 Peter 1:18-19 ...you were ransomed from the futile ways inherited from your forefathers, not with perishable things such as silver or gold, but with the precious blood of Christ, like that of a lamb without blemish or spot.

Hebrews 10:10 we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. (cf. 13:12)

hagios = holy, set apart
hagiozon = makes holy, sets apart

How did God make you holy?

hagion = holy ones, saints

"Be holy"—Live holy (set yourself apart to God)
