- The quality of condition of being true
- A verified fact; a true statement
- That which is real, certain, absolute
- True, genuine, actual, factual, true as opposed to false,
- verifiable statement or fact

Ps. 25:5 (Golden Text) "Lead my in thy truth . . ."

firmness, faithfulness, truth  
sureness, reliability, stability, continuance  
divine instruction, true doctrine, truth as a body of religious knowledge

### **Truth:** *althea* 225 in Greek:

John 8:32 "Ye shall know the truth. . ."

what is true in any matter under consideration  
according to the truth  
reality, the fact, certainly  
what is true in things appertaining to God and the duties of man, moral and religious truth  
free from affection, presence, simulation, falsehood, deceit

### **Salvation:** *yesha* 3468

Deliverance, salvation, rescue, safety, welfare  
Victory  
God of my help  
My helper (savior)

### **Foundation:**

- that on which something is founded or based

  - the base on which something stands
