Names of Jesus

Before class: Bring a book that lists names and their meanings, or look them up before you come to class and write the meaning of their name on a die-cut of a boy or girl for them to take home.

Begin class by asking the students if their names have a meaning. many parents choose a name for their child because of its meaning.

Jesus, the Greek form of the Hebrew name Joshua means 'Jehovah is salvation,'

The Bible uses many symbols to describe Jesus such as the Lamb of God. He also uses many titles like the Christ or Messiah which means the anointed One.

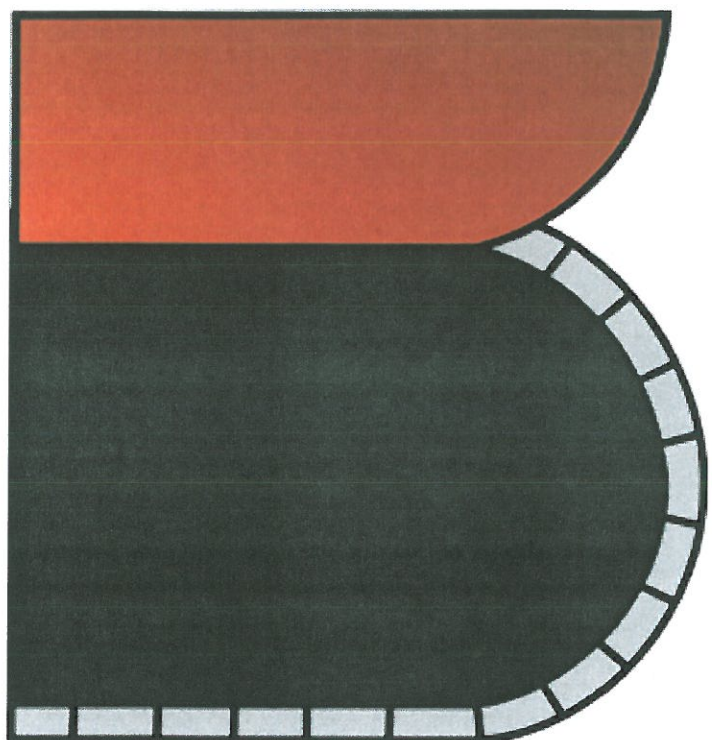
