 metals into gold: 1828

Frankincense: Theology

- used as incense in worship
- used at the altar in the tabernacle
- incense: a symbol of deity
- symbolizing prayer

Myrrh Medicine:

- was medicinal and related to medicine
- used on the sponge as a narcotic when Jesus was crucified
- (an embalming oil) a symbol of death
