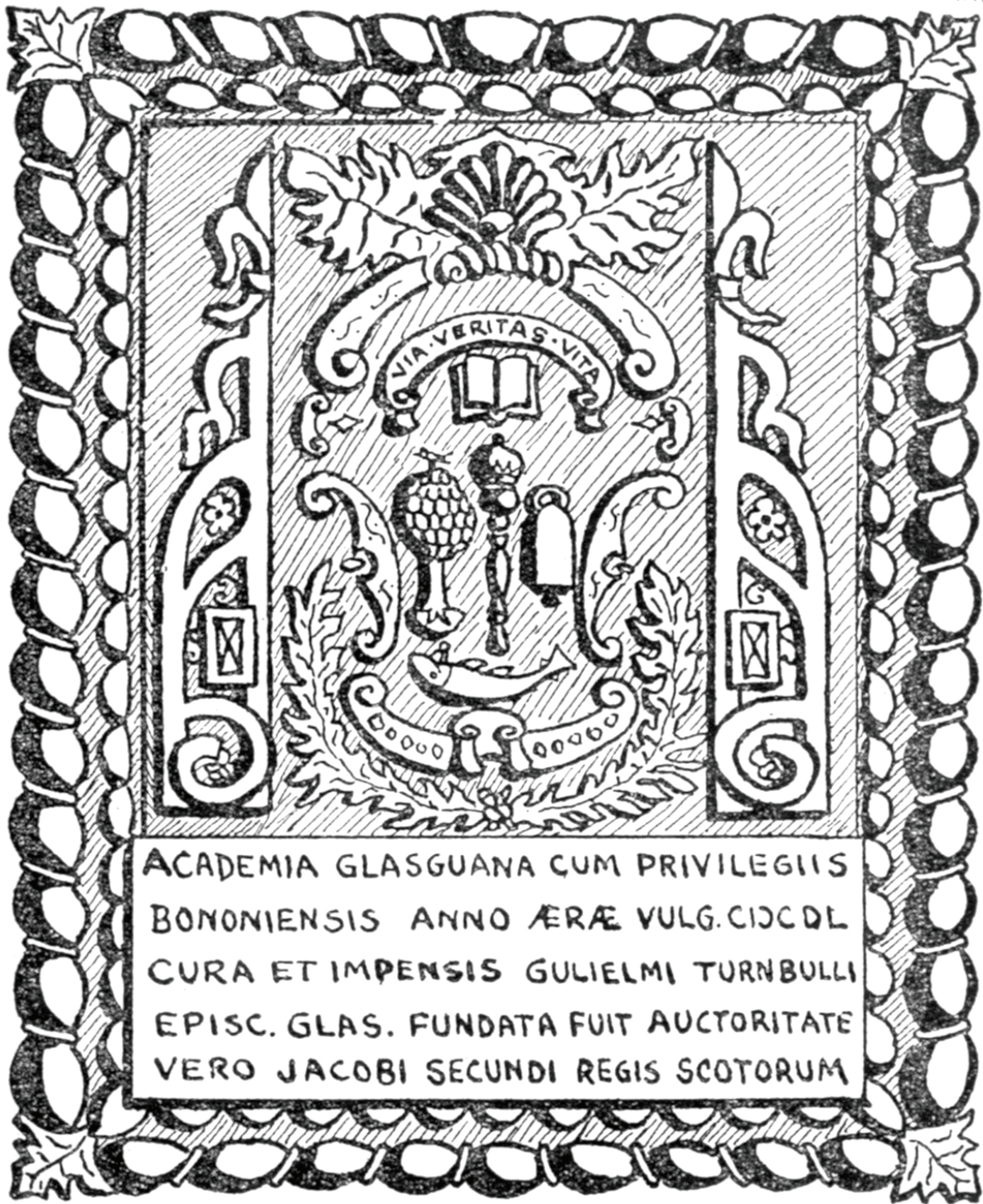

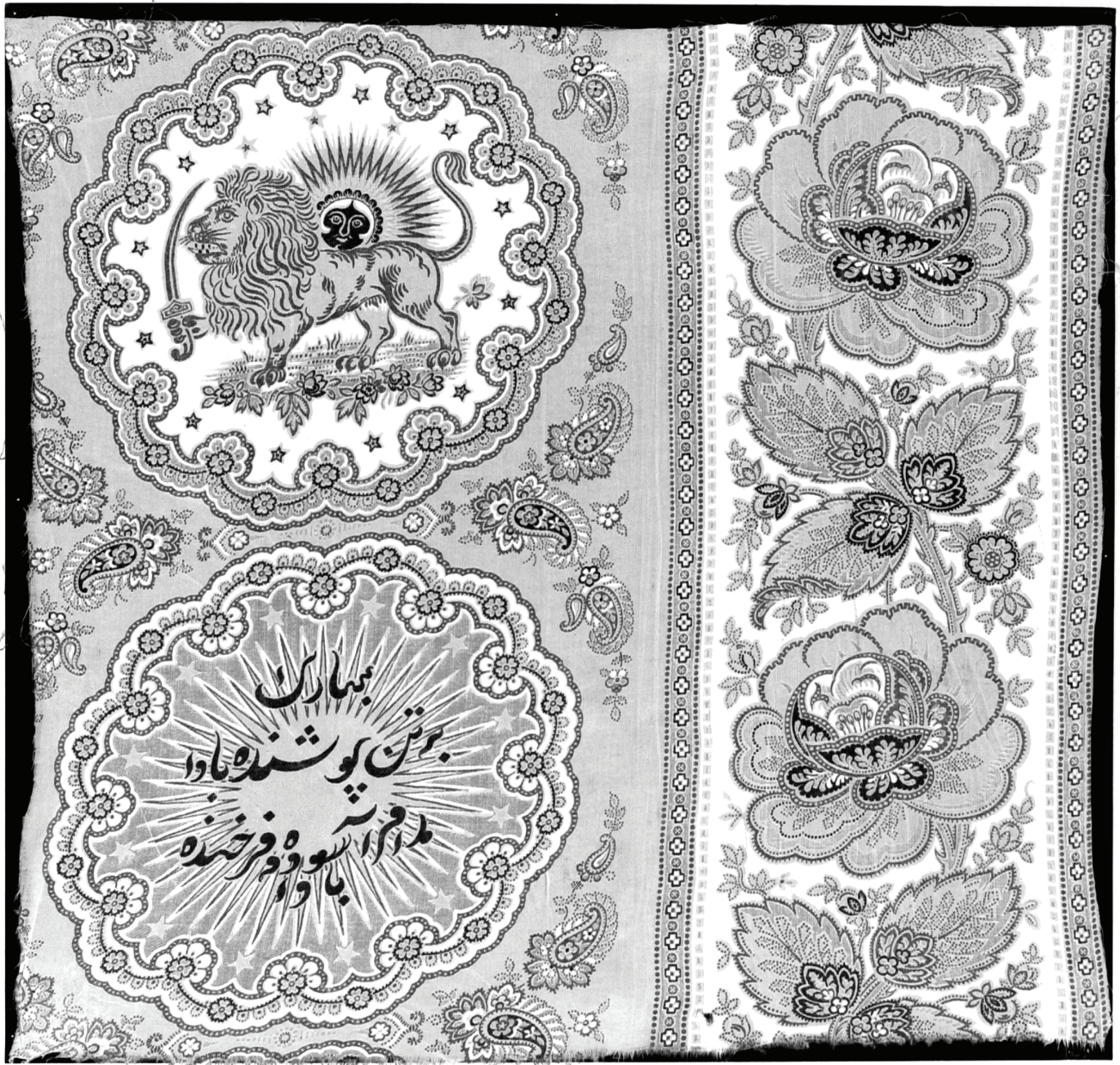

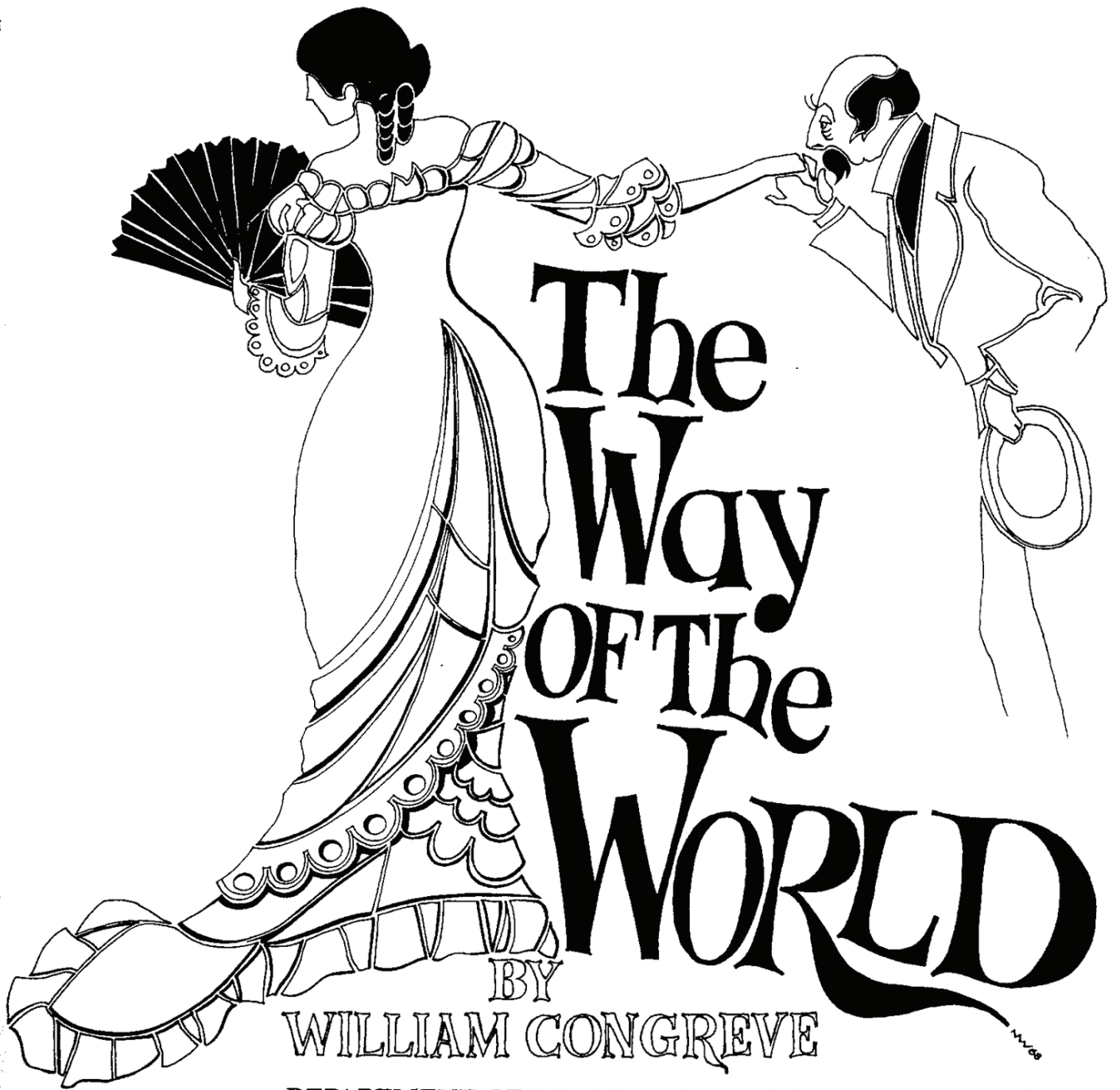

him

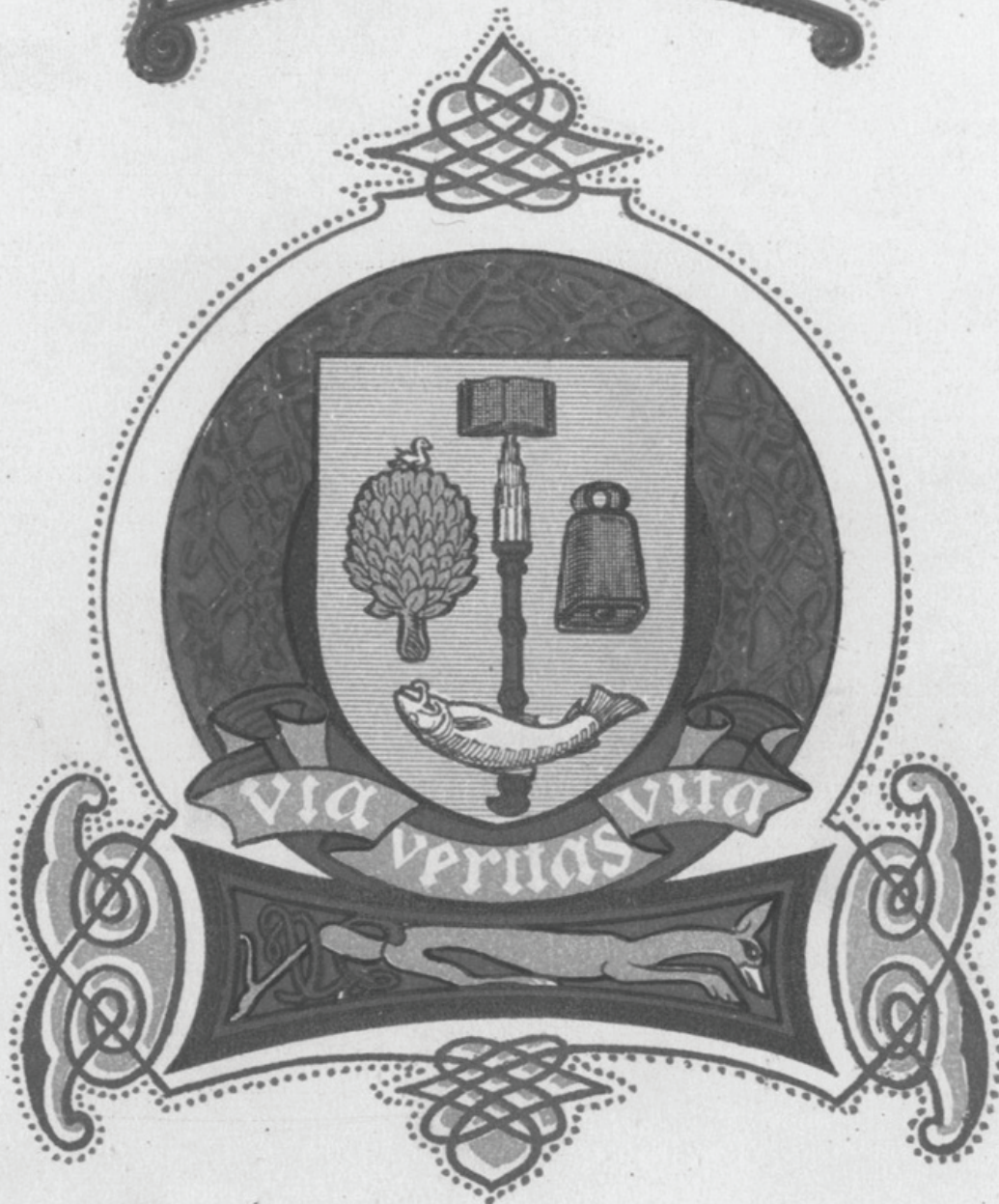

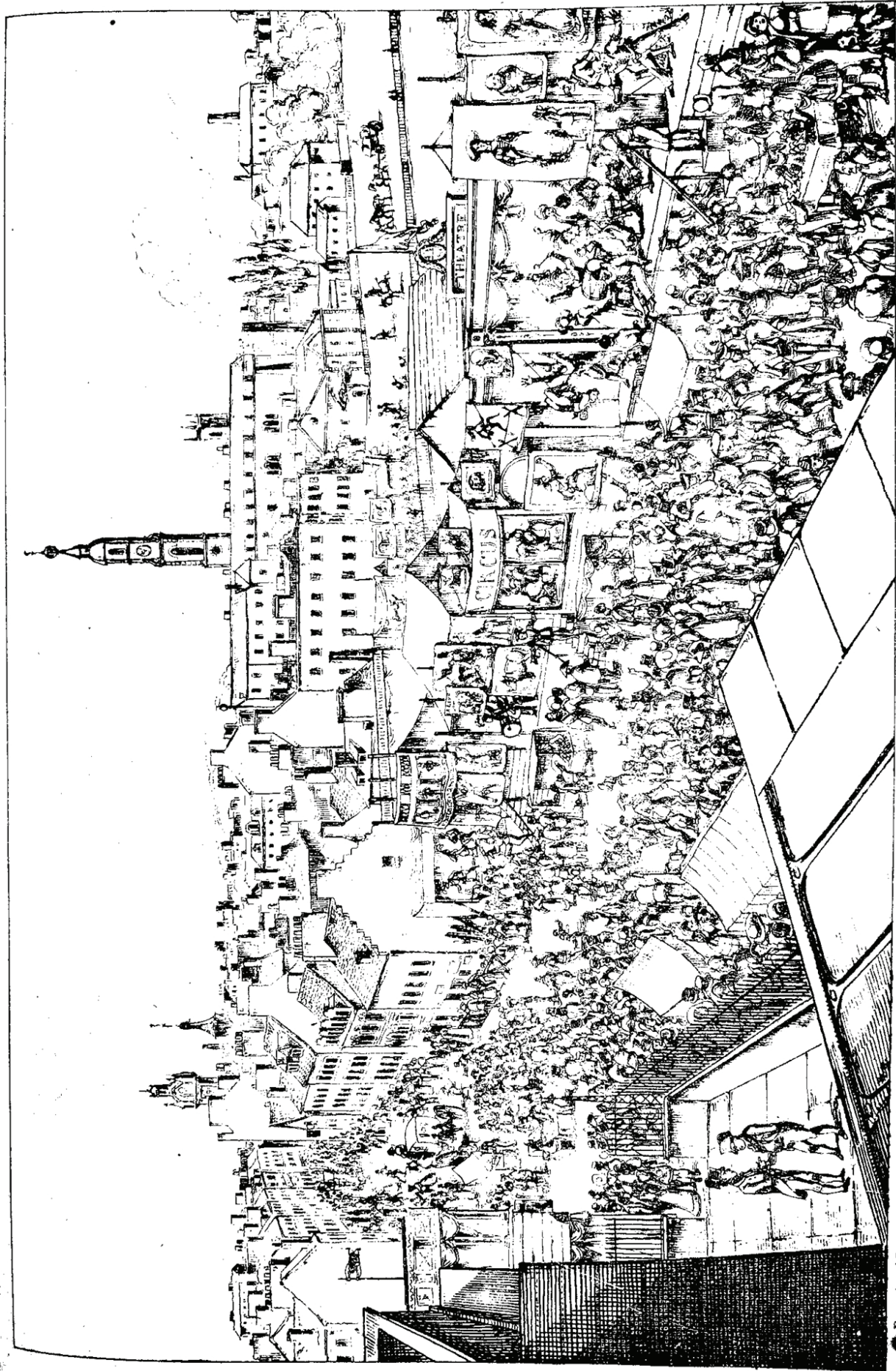


Hypnerotomachia Poliphili by Francesco Collonna, 1499. Hunterian Collection.

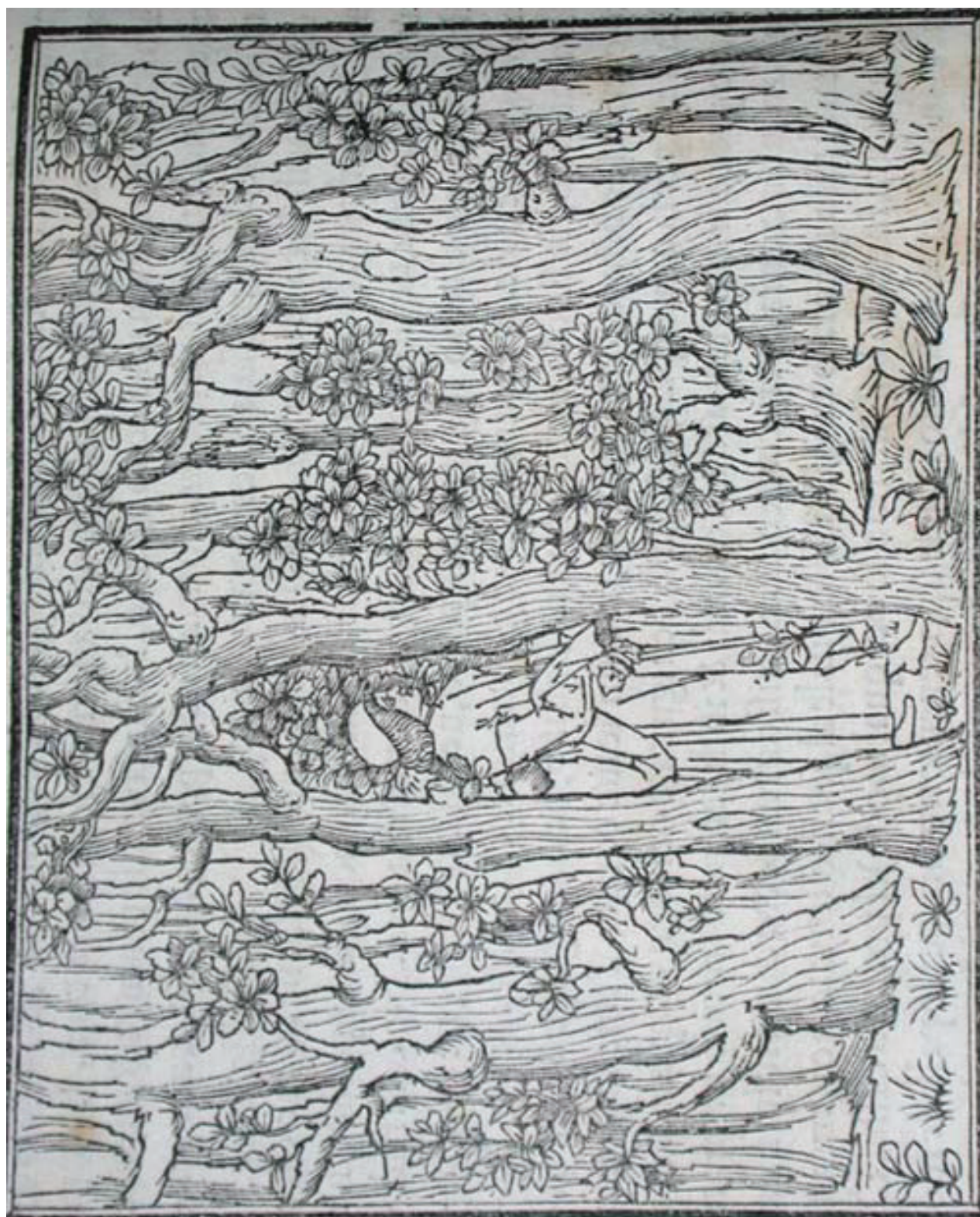
