The NJ Tree Foundation will be planting 15 Trees in Jersey City on Saturday October 3, 2015

The NJ Tree Foundation, and their community-based **Renaissance Tree Program (RTP Team)** will be joining forces with the grass roots efforts of **Tree-Lined JC Streets**, in planting 15 new trees in downtown Jersey City this Saturday. Dedicated volunteers will join our collaborative event on Saturday, October 3rd from 9am-12pm at 269 Varick St in Jersey City, to help beautify the streets and add to a more ecologically sound urban landscape for Jersey City.

Nick Milak, a Jersey City resident, started an online crowd-funding campaign to restore his local block. Within the first few days, several hundred people reached out expressing their interest and support for this effort on a larger scale. With such a high level of response, Milak was inspired to create a team of various community organizations to serve as a collaborative force to tackle this issue with their respective levels of expertise. The Jersey City Environmental Commission, Sustainable JC, and The JC Parks Coalition were gathered to yield a higher impact and build a collaborative network as this model project is launched. All organizations involved are extremely excited for the kick-off event on Saturday Oct. 3rd.

Tree planting events are a great opportunity to highlight the positive people in Jersey City. Community involvement is essential to the Renaissance Trees Program, and every planting has its own story. We invite you to capture this story and highlight the event from the perspective of the amazing volunteer leaders that make these plantings possible and encourage wide participation as the initiative builds.

Tree-Lined JC Streets seeks to add to the momentum by acting as a platform for everyday citizens to get involved and serve as champions for their respective neighborhoods. The idea is to get individuals, community orgs and City agencies to collaborate and maximize our collective impact, and minimize wasted efforts for widespread beautification and urban ecology-focused benefits across Jersey City."

"The Tree-Lined JC Streets initiative is amazing - this type of enthusiastic and collaborative response to the needs of the community is the foundation for thriving neighborhoods. Friends of the Walkway, was formed with the same kind of neighborhood spirit, and was able to successfully save 84 mature shade trees from being destroyed along the waterfront walkway that surrounds Society Hill. With the help of Sustainable JC, the Friends of the Walkway were able to connect and collaborate with key community groups and supportive city agencies (JCDPW; JC City Planning and JC Environmental Commission). Community

groups supporting each other are able to pool resources and knowledge that benefits everyone – the combined synergy moves important projects like Tree-Lined JC Streets along much faster, and will have a greater impact if we all work together."
