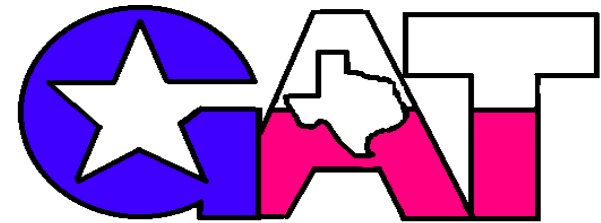

2011 LIFE MEMBER AWARD

PRESENTED TO:

KEVIN MAZEIKA

Kevin, though a native Houstonian, became involved in gymnastics in Rochester, New York where he and his family had spent four years while his Dad worked on his doctorate degree. While there, Mom put the kids in a YMCA gymnastics class. At age 4 Kevin climbed to the top of the rope and knew then that gymnastics was for him. Back in Texas, Kevin continued in gymnastics, coached by Bob Finch, John Charzuk, Mike Spiller and Bill Austin to name a few. He graduated from Lamar HS where he was their tumbling and mini-tramp mascot. Kevin earned a scholarship to Southern Illinois University, where he was a successful gymnast and where legendary Hall of Famer, Bill Meade, coached and mentored him. After hanging up the grips, Kevin went on to coaching in 1984. During his coaching career Kevin has coached at over 40 international events including; Men's Team Head Coach at 4 World Championships (including 2011) where the USA teams placed 4th in 2007 and earned 2 Silver Medals (2003, 2001). Kevin was also Head Coach of the 2004 and 2008 USA Men's Olympic Teams that won Silver Medal and Bronze Medals respectively. He has been personal coach of 2 Olympic Team members, 7 World Championships Team members, 10 World Cup Medalists, and 19 athletes who made 52 National Teams and won 33 National event and AA titles. Kevin has been named USAG "Coach of the Year" in 1998, 2001 and 2002. He received the "Order of Ikkos" medal from the USOC in 2008. Kevin's Olympic success is in the Congressional Records in Washington D.C. In 2010 Kevin was inducted into the USA Gymnastics Hall of Fame. Currently, he is USA Men's National Team Coordinator and resides in Houston. He is married to Laura and they have two daughters; Morganne a HS senior and Courtney a junior at University of Texas. Elected 2011.

2011 LIFE MEMBER AWARD

FRANK KUDLAC**

Frank, a native of Binghamton, New York, was born into a family with a rich history and appreciation for the sport of gymnastics ... grandfather, father, mother, sister ... all excelled in gymnastics.

As a youngster he started his gymnastics through SOKOL. He attended West Chester University (PA) where he competed as an all-rounder and was team captain his senior year. The West Chester Rams were conference champions the first three years of Kudlac's career and finished as conference runner-up his senior year. He graduated in 1978 with a B.S degree in P.E.

He moved to Denton in 1978, entered graduate school at TWU and earned his Master's Degree in 1981. During those graduate years he started a club gymnastics team with seven women recruited from his classes and on campus. He quickly nurtured this group into a varsity squad in 1980, and has successfully built it into a nine-time USA Gymnastics Collegiate National Champion and two-time Midwest Independent Conference (MIC) champion. He has coached numerous USAG Individual National Champions, All-Americans, Academic All-American, and NCAA Post Graduate Scholars. He is a nine-time NCAA Division II Coach of the Year.

In addition to teaching in the department of Kinesiology at TWU Frank also owns and manages Achievers Gymnastics Center, a private gym in Denton. In 1994 he added international experience to his resume when he served as an assistant coach at the Goodwill Games in St. Petersburg, Russia. Frank was inducted into the West Chester University Athletic Hall of Fame on February 16, 2008. After coaching 33 years at Texas Woman's University, Frank retired in May of 2011. Elected 2011.

Carol is currently the New SJD in Texas. Since the early 80's, she has given back to gymnastics a deep devotion and strong desire to play the sport forward. A graduate from Central High School in San Angelo, Tx. she competed under the guidance of James White. She is a High School All American on the Uneven Bars back in the day when uneven bars were quiet different than today. Later she graduated from Southwest Texas State (Texas State) where she was the assistant coach to the gymnastics team under Darlene Schmidt who inspired her to start a gymnastics age group team.

Carol has served GAT as a past Secretary and past President of the Gymnastics Association of Texas.

As the District 4 assignor for the Texas USA SAC Carol has been an avid supporter of the 2,3,4 program and helped gymnastics grow in her District She has enjoyed gymnastics as a competitor, judge, coach, and gym owner helping others to achieve their gymnastics goals.

USA Gymnastics National Junior Olympic Committee Compulsory co-author for 2005-2013, and is currently completing her work, co-authoring the next set of USA Gymnastics Compulsory routines for 2013-2020.
Coach for several international events including the Pacific Alliance Championships, World Championships, 1991 Pan American Games and World University Games
She worked at the 1996 Olympic games and was a member of the U.S. delegation to the 1999 World Gymnaestrada.
She was the co-founder and CEO of Gymnastics Educational Workshop for pre-school and recreational coaches
She has been a National lecturer for USA Gymnastics, Academy of Coaching Excellence, Gymnastics Association of Texas, and Gymnastics Educational Workshops
She was also a Physical Education teacher at Robert E. Lee High School in San Antonio, Texas
She earned her Bachelor of Science in Education, Health and Dance from Texas State University in 1978
Prior to leaving Texas, as many of you know, she was the Educational Director for Gymnastics Association of Texas. Under her guidance, GAT developed an outstanding reputation throughout the country as one of the leading educational conferences in the United States. Her vision led to the creation of the Instructor Training Programs we now have for anyone who wishes to train in coaching Preschool gymnastics, Recreational gymnastics, Compulsory Women's team, Boy's classes, Men's Team, or Office Management.

No other state has the depth of coaching education that we have right here in Texas. It is largely because of Cheryl's tireless work, incredible passion for our sport, and dedication to coaching education that we are so blessed.

Cheryl now serves our sport as of January 31, 2011 as the USA Gymnastics Vice President of Member Services. Her responsibilities include the overall direction and management of the Member Services Division, which includes membership administration, sanctions, education and member club activities.

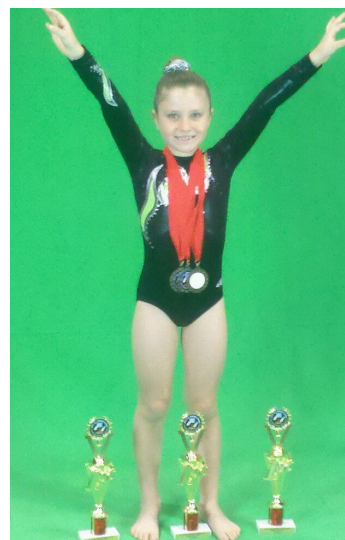
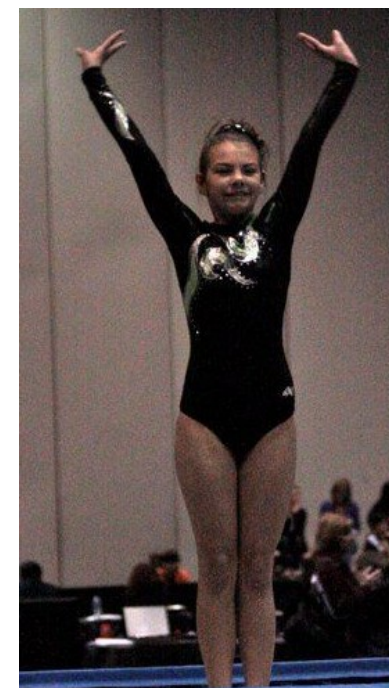
