### **TRUMBULL SCHOOL WINNING BID ANNOUNCED**

The Board of Education has chosen the highest bidder in the Trumbull RFP process: Svigos Development. The Svigos proposal includes condominiums and a space for Timeline Theater Company on the first floor. The second highest bidder was the Waldorf School; as runner-up, Waldorf will have the opportunity to pursue its bid should the deal with Svigos fall through. The Svigos proposal was deemed acceptable to the community during the RFP process, both through the community surveys that were taken and by the representatives of neighborhood groups who worked with Alderman O'Connor's office. According to his website, Alderman O'Connor has requested renderings of the Svigos plans and will make them available to the community. We continue to monitor the situation and will inform the neighborhood as we receive additional information.

**WEST ANDERSONVILLE GARDENS**

Thanks to everyone who joined us for West Andersonville Gardens' 20th anniversary celebration in June. Because we are avid gardeners, the celebration began with planting the triangular area just south of Berwyn. This area now gives a "preview" of plants you will see in the rest of the garden. These include "Nearly Wild" shrub roses, dwarf variegated red twig dogwoods, a nine bark, an Annabelle hydrangea, and an upright yew. For fun, look at this triangle and then see where you can find its plants in the rest of the garden. Thanks to everyone who helped make this planting a reality. A special thanks to our garden designers Bill Coons and Suzanne Flemens who created the design and obtained the plants.

But what is a celebration without food! After our planting we adjourned to our lawn chairs and enjoyed a sumptuous spread of Italian sandwiches, humus, veggies, fruit and chips. The pièce de résistance was a cake from the Swedish Bakery recognizing "20 Blooming Years". Thanks to our food committee Dennis Hensley, Susan Taylor, and Robin Wold for satisfying our palates and to Dena Gordon for donating the colorful paper goods. Our delightful lunch was made possible by the generosity of our wonderful Andersonville merchants: Piatto Pronto, 5624 N. Clark; Edgewater Produce, 5509 N. Clark; Jewel-Osco, 5516 N. A historical note: For many years we worked with GreenCorps, a city program that trained folks in landscaping skills while aiding community gardens. They were always very happy to come to our garden because we had the best food, thanks to our generous local merchants!

Another important part of our 20th Anniversary Celebration, is our banner which has hung in the garden this year. Thanks to Judy Stastinger and to Barbara Laing of Painted Light Photography & Framing, 1742 W. Balmoral, for creating it.

Visitors to the garden may ask: "what about the bare, unsightly embankment above the beautiful new planting at Berwyn?" Answer: Join us on Saturday, October 17 to plant the area with wildflower seeds. This is an experiment for us and will take 3-5 years to really display the fruits of our seeding; check back from time to time to see how it is working. The 17th will be your last opportunity to participate in West Andersonville Gardens this year. In addition to the seeding we'll be readying the garden for WANT's Ghostly Garden later in the month and sharpening our garden tools in preparation for next year's work!

We will meet at Ravenswood (east of the METRA tracks) and Berwyn and work from 9:00 a.m. to noon.

As always, come when you can. Even an hour of your time is a big help. We will have gloves and tools for you to use, but feel free to bring your own. Hope to see you there.

## LAND USE AND ZONING REPORT

The biggest news in the WANT area is the announcement from Alderman O'Connor's office on August 24th that the Trumbull School RFP (Request For proposal) process has identified Svigos Development as the highest bidder on for purchase of the property, with the Waldorf School coming in 2nd. According to the email newsletter, Svigos will partner with TimeLine Theater Company to occupy the first floor public space with the building to be renovated as residential. Chicago Development Corporation and Harold Weiner originally brought the proposal with TimeLine to the community meeting which was held approximately one year ago, as Svigos planned to partner with grocer Fresh Farms at that time. It remains to be seen how Svigos would like to deal with some of the specific components of the site, such as the parking lot area to the West of the building. WANT's Land Use and Zoning Committee plans to meet with the Alderman prior to the next WANT general meeting on September 28th so that additional details may be provided at that time.

During the last general meeting, several questions were posed with answers as follows: regarding an announcement and inquiry as to whether a demo permit has been applied for at property adjacent to and South of the new 6 unit development at the former Ravenswood Pub, public records show that a demo permit has been applied for but not yet issued as of September 7th (the Committee was asked by the developer of the Pub site if another 6 unit could be built there and voted to not allow that) and no request has been formally presented to develop that site with anything not conforming to the current RS3 Zoning (single family house or two flat); regarding a question about a building permit being issued for the vacant property at 5354 North Paulina, where the original farmhouse had been rehabbed and subsequently torn down, a new single family application is expected from the owner (conforming to RS3), and upon investigation no new permit has yet been applied for. For further updates, answers to questions, or to volunteer to work on any of the various WANT committees, please attend the next general meeting!
