LAND USE AND ZONING REPORT

Last month there were two requests for Zoning Changes in the WANT area that were on the October 27 agenda for the City Council Committee on Zoning, both of which were deferred.

The first is the well know request for the Trumbull School. Notices for the proposed Zoning Amendment were sent out to neighbors of the school, and described a new 4 story building in addition to the existing building renovation and conversion into residential use which surprised some residents who had been following the process since no new buildings were to be included in the approved Request for Proposals (RFP's). Upon further examination of the notices, it became apparent that the notice had been sent in error and was for changes proposed for a different school property being purchased by the same developer, Svigos, located at 739 North Ada. The matter has been deferred until correct notices are sent, and in addition there needs to be an agreement in place with the TimeLine Theater before this can be approved.

The other request for a Zoning Change is for the AB Marathon at Bryn Mawr & Ashland, in order to allow them to expand their auto service shop from the present two service bays to three, with a 593.6 square foot single story addition. This is necessary since the parcel was rezoned to RS3 as part of the WANT downzoning that was passed over a decade ago. The WANT Board and Zoning Committee requested the item not be approved at this time, since two neighbors have expressed opposition to this proposal. Approval will only be forthcoming if AB Marathon can persuade the neighbors to withdraw their opposition.

Did you know the plastic bags aren't recyclable? Streets & Sanitation has announced that as of January 1, all recyclables must be placed loose in the city's blue carts. Recyclables contained in any bags, paper or plastic, will no longer be accepted.

Andersonville's Lucia celebration includes a procession starting at 4:45 pm from the Museum and returns for a program at 5:00 pm.


At 7 pm, the celebration continues at Ebenezer Lutheran Church, 1650 W. Foster, with holiday songs, readings and procession.
