LAND USE AND ZONING REPORT

There have been no recent requests for Zoning changes or Zoning Variations this past few months in the WANT area. There has been construction activity recently, so far it appears this is all “by right” development, that is, projects which conform to the requirements of the Chicago Zoning Ordinance. The WANT area is zoned RS3, which allows new single family residences and two flats (in some cases), as well as renovation of other types of existing buildings, but not building additions.

Public Notice regarding the proposed Zoning change (technically a Map Amendment) for the Trumbull school building conversion to multi-family residential use (as well as for the TimeLine Theater) can be seen posted on the building along Ashland Avenue. The Alderman has stated that and there needs to be an agreement in place with the TimeLine Theater before the Zoning change can be finalized. We have heard no news, and the website for the developer Svigos has no information.

On February 19th, Alderman O'Connor's newsletter announced the purchase of the Edgewater Medical Center site by developer MCZ and approval by the Chicago Plan Commission of the proposed redevelopment including a park space, adaptive reuse of former hospital buildings, and including such features as green roofs.

The owner of the property at 5354 N. Paulina has decided to sell the vacant site after owning the property for about a year as evidenced by a sign that went up in January. With the tumultuous history of the property over the past few years, we are anxiously awaiting any news of the possible redevelopment of the site.


