1.	Any burning must only take place in a chiminea.
2.	Burning is limited to clean, dry wood or charcoal.
3.	There must be an attendant at the scene of the chiminea fire, and the fire must be completely extinguished
	before the attendant shall leave
4.	No person shall set or maintain a fire in a chiminea unless he or she ensures all of the following conditions are met:
	a. The chiminea:
	i. Is not located on a balcony;
	ii. Is not located on any combustible surface;
	iii. Is in good working order; and
	iv. Is located at least three (3) metres from any building or structure;
	b. All openings in the chiminea are completely covered by metal wire mesh with grid openings no larger
	than 12 millimetres in diameter;
	c. The fire is confined to the chiminea;
	d. The person burns only clean dry wood or charcoal in the chiminea; and
	e. The person sets and maintains the fire in the chiminea only during the time falling between two (2)
	hours before sunset and two (2) hours after sunrise of the following day, unless such person has the
_	prior written consent of the Fire Chief to set or maintain the fire in the chiminea during any other time.
5.	The undersigned applicant hereby acknowledges that chimineas must be at least 3 metres from any buildings or
	other structure, including fences.
6.	The undersigned applicant herby acknowledges that the Community will not be held responsible for conditions
	which may cause the blowing of sparks, ashes, and/or smoke.
7.	The undersigned applicant herby acknowledges that in the event of any forgoing conditions are not complied
	with, this notification shall become null and void and the undersigned applicant shall be liable for any damage
	to public and/or private property caused by the fire and shall also be liable for the full cost of extinguishing the
	fire.
8.	The undersigned applicant acknowledges that this notification is issued pursuant to By-Law Number 14-16 as
	subsequently amended, and that every person who contravenes any provision of the said By-Law is guilty of an
	offense and shall, be liable, upon conviction, to the penalties provided by the Provincial Offenses Act R.S.O.
