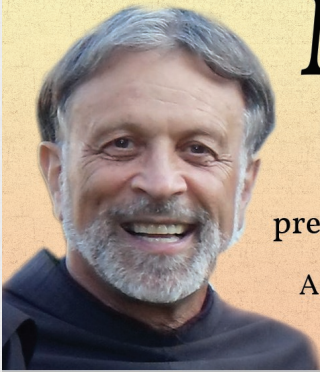

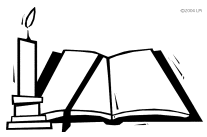

Although we engage in sacrifice and self-denial during Lent, we come to a point of joy and anticipation on the Fourth Sunday of Lent, known as "Laetare" (Rejoice) Sunday, of the Resurrection at Easter. Since St. Patrick's Day is this Tuesday and St. Joseph's Day is this Thursday, we honor both of these great saints with music this weekend. St. Patrick, the Patron Saint of Ireland, is honored with the Prelude and the special Communion Meditation by our tenor soloist, Paul Condon. The Postlude/Recessional, sung by the Choir (11:30) and instrumental at other Masses, is in honor of St. Joseph, foster father of Jesus, and the Patron Saint of Italy.

On the Feast of the Epiphany, we had the Brass Quintet here to play. They will return during Lent and when they are here there will be a separate program sheet. They will also play at Easter Liturgies. Our parishioners enjoyed their music and were uplifted by the Quintet. I am anxious to have them return.
