

Last week's Psalm 98 provided the Entrance Antiphon and it is the source of today's Responsorial Psalm. The New Testament Reading today, as well as the Gospel have as their theme the universal concept of love in all of it's meanings and permutations. Our hymns touch on this theme. The Processional Hymn sings of the wonders of nature during this time of spring awakening. Saint Francis of Assisi is credited with writing the words of this hymn.

We honor our mothers today, whether they are living or deceased. The Choir Anthem, "A Mother's Love" sings *"A mother's love knows no end. It's from the heart of God."* Let us not forget Mary, the Mother of God, who is the mother of all the human race, and in her title of "The Immaculate Conception, is the Patron Saint of our country. Holy Mother Church is our spiritual guide, and gift of Jesus to us. A Happy Mother's Day to all.

Recently Michael Melara, Onondaga County Director of Catholic Charities, shared with us ways that you can change the lives of the hurting in our Diocese through your donation to the HOPE Appeal.



The In-Pew Portion of the HOPE Appeal will be next weekend - May 16 and 17.

Our parish goal is \$121,997. This is an increase of 6% from last year. I am asking each family to consider a pledge of \$300 or just 82C per day. Last year Holy Cross received back 50% of the overage or \$94,483.17, which we used for Internet Technology, Young Adult Ministry, Evangelization, Youth Ministry, Outreach & other programs of service.


