

HOPE Appeal

I would like to thank all who participated last weekend during the in-pew portion of this year's appeal.



If you have not joined us for the Hope Appeal....

Please consider being a part of the 2015 Appeal. Our parish goal is \$121,997, a 6% increase. Last year with a goal of \$115,072 you gave \$300,038 or 265% of the goal for an average family gift of \$453.00.

This year I am asking each family to prayerfully consider a gift of \$300 or just 82¢ per day.

50% of the overage is returned to the parish. This year we received \$94,483.00 and that we used for Internet Technology, Young Adult Ministry, Evangelization, Youth Ministry, Outreach & other programs of service.


