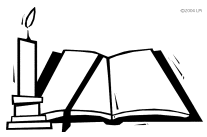

## HOPE Appeal

**I would like to thank all who participated last weekend during the in-pew portion of this year's appeal.**



**If you have not joined us for the Hope Appeal....**

Please consider being a part of the 2015 Appeal. Our parish goal is \$121,997, a 6% increase. Last year with a goal of \$115,072 you gave \$300,038 or 265% of the goal for an average family gift of \$453.00.
