

### **Message from Matthew Lyons**

Dear Holy Cross Church,

I consider it a blessing to have spent the past year with you all. This weekend (June 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>) will be my last full weekend here for the summer. However, I will be returning to Holy Cross briefly at the beginning of August to receive what is called the Rite of Candidacy.

Candidacy is another step towards ordination to the diaconate and priesthood. All those preparing for ordained ministry receive candidacy. The rite itself is a short ceremony at Mass, after the homily, in which a seminarian publicly states his intention to devote himself to study and prayer in preparation for ordination to the diaconate and priesthood. He is officially recognized as a candidate for those orders.

I will be receiving Candidacy at Holy Cross on August 2<sup>nd</sup> at the 11:30am Mass. In the meantime I will be away on a 30-day silent retreat, following the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola. Please keep me in your prayers during this time. I hope to see you all again at the beginning of August!
