


Blessing of the Bambinelli (Baby Jesus) ~ 'Welcome Sun-

day', Dec 19th & 20th. This is a beautiful Roman tradition celebrated by the Pope each year during Advent. Holy Cross will celebrate this tradition in on "Welcome Sunday" weekend, December 19th and 20th. Please mark your calendar now! All of our families (households) are asked to bring to church your Baby Jesus from the family nativity scene for a special blessing. (If you don't have one – we will have one for you!)

Jubilee Year of Mercy begins Dec 8, 2015 and concludes Nov 20, 2016

Jesus is the the "face of the Father's mercy". Pope Francis writes: "It is absolutely essential for the Church and for the credibility of her message that she herself live and testify to mercy." Mercy, he says, is "the beating heart of the Gospel" (Misericordiae Vultus). To live mercy, we must rediscover both the spiritual works of mercy (counsel the doubtful, instruct the ignorant, admonish sinners, comfort the afflicted, forgive offences, bear patiently those who do us ill, and pray for the living and the dead), and the corporal works of mercy (feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, clothe the naked, welcome the stranger, heal the sick, visit the imprisoned, and bury the dead). Which spiritual works of mercy might Christ be calling you to practice? Which corporal works of mercy? Adapted from USCCB.

Syracuse University's Enactus students will be selling Guatemala Mayan weavers' products after Masses on **December 12th & 13th.** Please stop by their table inside the church main entrance and support their efforts to provide scholarships for the Mayan weavers' daughters. The average income for Mayan families in Guatemala is under \$3 a day, and the cost of attending secondary school can reach \$250 a year. As a result, less than one percent of Mayan girls graduate from high school. Since 2007, SU Enactus students have provided over 240 scholarships through the sale of the Mayan weavers' products.
