Two contrasting meals frame today's Gospel. The first is a backdrop and the second is the focal point. Behind the story of John the Baptist's death is a decadent banquet for the rich where Salome requests the head of John as a gift from Herod. In today's Gospel Jesus, though grief-stricken over the news of John's death, reaches out to feed 5000 poor people at the edge of the sea. The text of today's Communion Hymn, "Come To The Water", is based on the first Reading from Isaiah. It fits well with the setting of Jesus feeding the 5000.

The Communion Meditation, sung by our bass/baritone soloist, Ryan Boyle, gives us the confidence that Jesus can still heal and feed us throughout our lives because He Is Risen and **Because He Lives!**

On this summer weekend we hear three more of Jesus' Parables and we sing hymns which underlines our love for the laws of the Lord. So, please don't sit there and be unwilling to sing. Go ahead, jump into the pool, **PICK UP THAT HYMNAL AND GIVE IT YOUR BEST SHOT! PLEASE!** If you love to sing, please consider joining the Adult Choir or one of the other Choirs.
