



"Holy Cross Faith in Action Committee members set up an apartment for our "adopted" refugee family from Somalia. A crew of volunteers dedicated their Saturday on May 31st to cleaning an apartment on the north side of Syracuse. Donated household goods from the "welcome door" project in May were used, along with used furniture and household appliances generously supplied by parish families. The community gave abundantly-the entire house was furnished and the closets were overflowing! Three teenage boys from the refugee family helped a few men from the parish to move the collected furniture from the rectory garage. Safiya Ada, a single mother of 9, arrived with the rest of the family by 4 pm. An impromptu celebration began when neighbors from the Somali community arrived to welcome them to their new home."

Members of the Holy Cross community have been meeting regularly with our adopted Somali family since the May 31rst move to their north side apartment. Khalid, the oldest boy, serves as our translator since he has some English speaking skills. Marisa Marron played baseball with the children and began teaching them some English words & phrases. Meg Aufmuth helped them learn how to do laundry and use the public library. John Fix helps as a handyman & tour guide; he set up the TV and a clothesline. Fr John and Aaron Hendricks took the older boys shopping for some American-style clothing. Barry Miller plans to take the family to the farmer's market and show them how to purchase fresh vegetables and fruit.

Khalid is a very attuned to American culture. He plans to be a runner and he has new running shoes (donated by a local organization) to match his ambition. He borrowed the Hunger Games and the Twilight Series movies from the library. He purchased a smartphone and is adding to it many photos & videos of himself and his friends. His favorite video is one he took in June of the local Somali community dancing at World Refugee Day in Schiller Park. The family is very grateful to our community for the friendship, furniture and housewares. Though they are part of the Muslim faith tradition, we pray that the work of the US Bishops, the local Catholic Charities Refugee Resettlement Program, and our friendship, will create an understanding of peace between our different faith traditions. We are making plans for the family to visit the parish soon, so you can welcome them personally and they can express their gratitude to you.
