The Prelude, Communion Meditation and Postlude are played on our grand piano this weekend to honor the many requests.

As we continue our celebration of the great Easter feast, the Adult Choir offers a beautiful setting of the text: "Alleluia. Amen." A work by the composer, Randall Thomson which sets to music only this short text, the word, "Alleluia" is sung by the choir more than 95 times, concluding with a single "Amen". It was commissioned in 1940 for the opening of the Tanglewood Festival, the summer home of the Boston Symphony Orchestra. Those who commissioned it expected the composer to write a triumphant, joyful piece, considering the title. The composer had a different idea. Sensing the inevitable participation of the United States in World War II, the composer delivered a bitter-sweet, subtle and yet PRAYERFUL, a cappella choral work, at once tentative, at once hopeful in the power of God to deliver the world from the coming catastrophe.! Though not what was expected, it was loved worldwide and has become a staple of choral literature. Please, let the music wash over you and be a prayer during this Easter season for the coming of a peaceful world! Ernest Camerota


