From Our Pastor

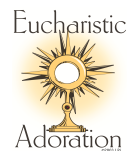

***LENTEN REGULATIONS** - Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are days of fast & abstinence. Catholics 14 years of age & older are bound to abstain from meat on the Fridays during lent. Catholics age 18 to 59 are bound to the law of fasting. (“The law of fasting allows only one full meal a day, but does not prohibit taking some food in the morning and evening, observing-as far as quantity & quality are concerned-approved local custom.”
