HOPE Appeal 2017

Our annual HOPE Appeal in-pew will be the weekend of May 20-21. Holy Cross has always been the leader in this campaign.

Last year our goal was \$122,382 and you contributed \$298,555 or 244% of the goal. The average gift from Holy Cross was \$485.

This year our goal is \$123,004. I am asking you to consider a pledge of \$310 per family or 85¢ a day—less than a bottle of water and we can change lives and bring hope to thousands of needy in our diocese.

Also because of your goodness Holy Cross received 1/2 of the overage or \$87,661 which went to the parish program of Evangelization, IT, Youth and Young Adult Ministry.
