History

Founded in 2012 by community sustainability organization Green Community Connections in Oak Park/River Forest Illinois.

Expanded to Chicagoland March 2014; the only event of its kind and reach in the region. One Earth Film Festival keeps sustainability top of mind for thousands of film festival supporters through email marketing, social media and original website content and articles.

Current Statistics:

- 2400 attendees from 88 zip codes and 6 states
- 5-fold attendance growth since inception
- 140 partners
- 200 volunteers
