Drop off / Pick Up: Parents should check their children in at the computer kiosks in the lobby each club night, and print out a name tag for each child containing a security ID code. Parents will receive a sticker with a matching code. Once checked in on the computer, parents must sign their children in at the classroom counter each night and indicate their cell number and where they can be located during club. At pick up, the parent must show the security ID tag. Teachers will match that tag to the one on the child before releasing the child.
