Realizing the Vision for Safe and Supportive Schools

In 2014, the Legislature incorporated the Safe and Supportive Schools law into its groundbreaking *Act Relative to the Reduction of Gun Violence*. The Legislature's vision was to help schools create safe and supportive whole-school cultures that effectively address many barriers to learning, such as substance abuse, gun violence, and bullying, so that all students can succeed in school. Continued support is crucial for spreading implementation across the Commonwealth.

The Safe and Supportive Schools Commission will issue its fourth annual report in February 2019 and is expected to recommend continued funding for the Safe and Supportive Schools Line Item. This funding would be used to accomplish the following:

- Continue the Safe and Supportive Schools Grant Program. Grantee schools use the Safe and Supportive Schools Framework and accompanying online Self-Assessment Tool. New Grantees develop school-wide Action Plans; Continutation Grantees implement them and include them in their annual School Improvement Plans; Mentor Grantees help others learn best practices.
- 2. Maintain DESE staffing that will continue to:
 - Coordinate the Grant Program
 - Hold state and regional trainings and conferences
 - Update the online Framework and Self-Assessment Tool
 - Provide technical assistance

- Staff the Commission
- Convene focus groups
- Collect feedback from students, families, experts and other stakeholders
- Develop and disseminate model practices
- Provide for statewide conferences and leadership summits to help spread the work beyond grantee schools and districts.
- 4. Conduct a second independent evaluation of the activities funded by the line item to help DESE and the Commission learn what is working well.
- Support schools to integrate and align student supports to improve student learning outcomes.
