About THE MANDELA PROJECT

“It is what we make out of what we have, not what we are given, that separates one person from another.”

THE MANDELA PROJECT was Tangle’s 2014 Discovery Project, inviting people from across South West England to take part in a range of creative activities to explore the ideas and purpose of Nelson Rolihlahla Mandela, writing their own creative statements in response to his vision for change.

THE MANDELA PROJECT aimed to encourage a wide range of people to adventure through a range of creative activities, which explored the life, purpose, and beliefs of a man who, with his friends and colleagues, changed the course of modern history.

During THE MANDELA PROJECT, we asked people of all ages and from all walks of life – ‘what do you believe in?’

The statements in this e-book form a collection of ideas around how participants hope to effect change locally, nationally and globally.

Nelson Mandela was one of the most prominent and talked about international figures of his time.

He dedicated his life to standing up for what he believed in.
