

Winter Car Survival Kit Checklist

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| Jumper Cables: flares or reflective triangle are great extras |
| Flashlights: Replace the batteries and pack some extras |
| First Aid Kit: Also add a bag of essential medications to have handy |
| <i>Water:</i> Have a min 1 gallon of water per person/per day for 3 days |
| Basic Tool Kit: Pliers, wrench, and screwdriver |
| Baby, special needs gear: Diapers, formula, etc |
| Food: Stock non-perishable food |
| Pet Supplies: Food and water |
| Radio: Battery or hand cranked |
| Cat litter or sand: For better tire traction |
| Shovel: To dig out of snow |
| <i>Ice Scraper:</i> Even if you park in garage, keep one in car |
| <i>Clothes</i> : Have a warm change of clothes; gloves, hats, & scarves |
| Warmers: Pack extra for body, hands, and feet |
| Blankets or Sleeping Bags: In case of being stranded while traveling |
| Charged Cell Phone: Keep a spare charger in car as well |
