The role of a mountain bike surveyor is to collect information from mountain bikers in Whistler in a non-biased manner. Our ideal candidate is a mature, outgoing, knowledgeable local who is available to work both weekends and weekdays and who enjoys talking to people. This is a paid position; surveyors will be compensated with an hourly wage as well as other benefits. Targets and additional incentives exist for questionnaire completion on a by-shift and by-season basis.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Acts as a Tourism Whistler ambassador, living our purpose and vision with passion & energy, and respect.
- Must be available for 2-3 shifts per week between May 15, 2015 - October 11, 2015 on Saturdays, Sundays, Tuesdays, and/or Thursdays.
- Shifts are 5 to 8 hours.
- Surveys are collected on mountain bike trails throughout Whistler.
- Surveying must be done in all weather conditions.
- Availability to work the May long-weekend (Friday May 15th – Monday May 18th) is an asset.
- Occasional evening and additional shifts required during Festivals and Events.
- Ability to arrange own transport to survey locations is required.
