Overview:

During the summer months WORCA hosts 5-day youth dirt camps and a daily schools program, fully coached to support youth aged 5 to 16 years. The focus of the Dirt Camps and programs is safety, fun, and mountain bike skill development. Each camp is capped with a 5:1 kid to coach ratio. Dirt camps run from 9am until 3pm from Monday to Friday and depart from/finish at the Waldorf School at the Spruce Grove Ball Diamonds. WORCA is looking for full-time and part-time coaches who have a passion for mountain biking and inspiring the next generation of riders. The positions will be supervised by a Head Coach and Lead Hand.

Who We Are Looking For:

The successful candidate will have experience working with youth, be physically fit, and a confident intermediate or advanced mountain biker. Coaches must be aged 18 years or older. The role will include, but is not limited to:

- Coaching youth aged 5-16 years in a camp/program environment;
- Demonstrating our core values around the WORCA DIRT CAMPS: Integrity, Community and Environment, Uncompromising Safety;
- Following best management practices as they evolve, including those set out by WORCA;
- Additional duties/responsibilities as required.

Skills, Knowledge and Required Competencies

- Level 1 Mountain Bike Instructor Development Program course or equivalent mandatory;
- Previous mountain bike instructing experience;
- Minimum Current OFA Level 1 (B.C. Certified) an asset;
- Experience supervising/coaching/instructing youth an asset;
- Strong mountain bike skills;
- Good physical condition;
- Local Whistler trail knowledge;
- Required to complete a criminal record check.
