Where: 1736 Superior Ave



What is Coordinated Intake?

Coordinated Intake is the FRONT DOOR to Emergency Shelter for individuals and families with no place to safely sleep.

Coordinated Intake provides:

- Exploration of alternatives to shelter
- Shelter Placement

After Hours:

- Single persons: If a single person needs shelter after 8pm they can go directly to 2100 Men's Shelter or Norma Herr Women's Center for a bed. They will need to come to Coordinated Intake the next day for an assessment.
- Families: If a family requires shelter after 8pm they need to call 211 which will review their shelter options. They will need to come to Coordinated Intake the following day for an assessment

The Coordinated Intake program is operated by FrontLine Service and Cleveland Mediation Center and is federally mandated and funded.
