What to order? A cappuccino in a delightful mug



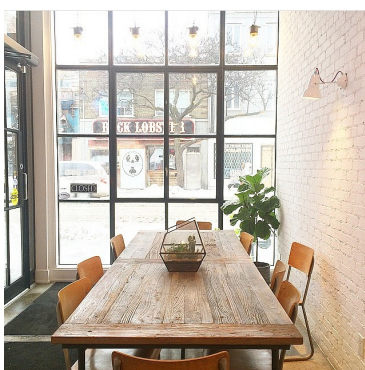
La Merceria
