Fabric suggestions: For Ballgown: Silk, silk taffeta, lawn, organdy, voile.

For Day Dress: Cotton, muslin, organdy, voile, linen, lawn, lightweight wool. Lining: I recommend 100% pima cotton or muslin for comfort and durability,

but acetate and other lining materials will also work.

Trim suggestions: Ribbon, piping, lace, braid, rosettes.

Notions: Thread, four 5/8" buttons or five 3/8" buttons.

Notes: 5/8" seam allowed except where noted on pattern pieces.

Yardage requirement will change if you need to lengthen or shorten

the skirt. Be sure to measure before purchasing fabric!
