We want those who do not yet know of our ministry to see an excellent ministry that cares to present itself in a way which gives glory and honor to God. Looking ahead at the way we have grown over the years, I know that we need to not only get ourselves up to date in our appearance and technology, but prepare for what the Lord has in store for us in the future.
