FEDERATION LUNCH WITH A LENGEND TO RELAUNCH PJ LIBRARY ON AUGUST 13

DENVER - (July 31, 2012)— The Allied Jewish Federation of Colorado (Federation) and PJ Library will celebrate a new partnership with a luncheon on Monday, August 13, 2012, 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at Brownstein Hyatt Farber Schreck, LLP. Harold Grinspoon, a real estate entrepreneur and philanthropist whose foundation launched PJ Library, will be a special guest at the luncheon. Grinspoon established the Harold Grinspoon Foundation in 1993 to promote Jewish life and education among young people, adults and families in North America and Israel. Since its founding, the foundation has generously provided more than \$120 million to programs, grants and operations throughout the Jewish world.

"Federation is honored to join forces with PJ Library to help continue its vision of inspiring family engagement in Jewish life through bedtime stories," said Doug Seserman, Federation's President and CEO. "Partnering with PJ Library is a natural fit, as its mission of strengthening Jewish identity and community is perfectly aligned with Federation's goals."

PJ Library mails free, high-quality Jewish children's literature and music to families on a monthly basis. PJ Library is now in 176 communities across North America. With more than 150,000 total subscriptions, PJ Library has given away over three million books. Federation is committed to raising more than \$300,000 over the next three years to support the PJ Library program. Additional support has been received through a generous grant from the Spitz/Tuchman Family Fund.

"The PJ Library program truly is building a stronger Jewish community, one book at a time," said Amy Toltz-Miller, Annual Campaign & Jewish Philanthropy Center Chair. "Federation's support of this unique and beneficial program will enable more families in Colorado to connect to their heritage and each other."
