I. Two Types of Knowing

- A. [G1492] eido: intuitive knowledge that is both perceived and understood. In this context, knowledge that can only come by the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit [1 Corinthians 2:16]
- B. [G1097] ginosko: to know by experience; in this context, key is an interactive relationship with Jesus Christ [2 Corinthians 4:6]
- II. Jesus Christ, the Ultimate Servant [John 13:1-17]
 - A. [13:1] "Jesus knew (eido) that they hour had come" [Eccles 3:1; Hab 2:3; Eccles 8:5-6]
 - B. [13:3] "Jesus knew (eido) that the Father had put all things under His power" [Luke 2:49]
 - C. [13:7] "You do not realize (eido) now what I am doing, but later you will understand (*ginosko*)" [Matthew 22:36-38; John 21:15-19; Ro 12:1-2]
 - D. [13:11] "For He knew (eido) who was going to betray Him" [1 Peter 3:9; John 6:64; Romans 2:4]
 - E. [13:12] "Do you understand (*ginosko*) what I have done for you?" [Philippians 2:1-11; Galatians 6:1-5]
 - F. [13:17] "Now that you know (eido) these things, you will be blessed if you do them" [Matthew 7:24-27]
