Adonai Tsevaot (Sabaoth).

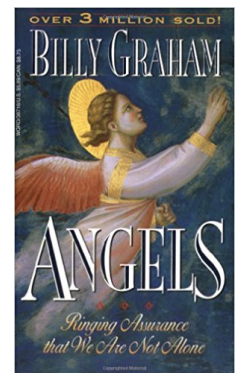
- The Lord of Hosts
- The Lord Almighty
- Captain of all the angelic armies. (God of angel armies)
- A mighty warrior king who leads armies into battle.
- 240 times throughout the Bible.

1 Samuel 17:45-49

King David uses the name Adonai Tsevaot as he challenges Goliath.

Angels:

- God’s messengers that can come to us in dreams or in person. (Matthew 1, Genesis 15)
- Protect us, physically carry us. (Matt 4:6)
- Minister to us. (Matt 4:11)
- “Guardian angels” (Matt 18:10)
- Rolled the stone in front of Jesus’ tomb. (Matt 28:2)
- Praise and worship God. (Luke 2:13)
- Ascending to heaven and descending from heaven. (John 1:51)
- Open prison doors and lead the apostles. (Acts 5:19)
- Give us clear directions. (Acts 8:26)
- Carry out God’s judgements. (Gen 19, Acts 12:23)
