ESOL

- An Umbrella Training ESOL course is for you if English is not your first language and you want to improve your speaking, listening, reading and writing skills.
- Our ESOL courses are general English courses designed to help develop the language skills necessary to live and work in the UK, for example, when looking for work, going to the doctor, shopping and meeting people.
- Our more advanced courses cover topical issues such as social media, politics, relationships and British culture, traditions and customs.
- Umbrella Training can deliver ESOL training at Entry 2, Entry 3, Level 1 and level 2.
- We will need to do an initial assessment so we can review entry levels and then we can start from that point.
- Groups (5 or more) we can offer group rates that can be discounted if rooms and refreshments are provided.
- We would need to agree a starting level as well so the group can be progressed at the same rate. The main aim would be to get them all to a level 2 within 12 months.
- On average the course will take 2-3 months of bi weekly 2 hour sessions which will be remote and face to face.
- A timeline will be put in place with the employer and schedules of activity.
