DATA ANALYSIS PROCESS

4-Part Data Sharing Strategy:

1. Summarize Data-Analysis Worksheet.
2. Identify target issue using Precise Problem Statement.
3. Explain the 6-part solution process to prevent the problem and teach/reinforce an alternative appropriate behavior that aligns with school-wide expectations.
4. Include a brief lesson or tips to increase staff skill to implement targeted interventions or solutions.

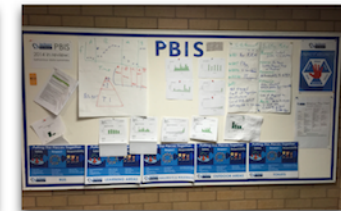
